	If a coach feels that athletes will not make the minimum field event standards, then
	he/she may want to consider not having them jump or throw in the event. There are no
	minimum standards for the High Jump or the Pole Vault. There is the six-jump rule and first jump clearance rule that automatically provides limitations for these events.

	<u>Distance Medley Relay:</u> Girls: 15:00 Boys: 13:00
	4x1600 Relay (One section only!): Girls: 24:30 Boys: 22:00
	Coaches should only enter teams that will run under the 4x1600 and the Distance Medley entry standards listed above.
Participation Rules:	M.I.A.A. rules will be in effect.
Participation Rules.	An athlete may participate in any three events.
	A relay counts as a running event.
	NFHS Uniform rules will be enforced.
Team/Athlete	'B' Teams:
Participation	'B' teams are allowed in all running events except the 4x1600m and the Distance
	Medley. 'B' teams are not allowed in the field events. Any coach who wishes to enter
	an exceptional 'B' team in the DMR, 4x1600 or a field event must contact the Meet
	Director by April 19. You must submit the names of the athletes that will make up each
	team and their potential performances. If approved, the meet director will add those B teams to the database.

	Entry fees are non-refundable. If you enter athletes into the meet, your school is responsible for
	payment of the entry fees, even if your athletes do not compete. If your school uses the Single
	Payment option, you complete the entry process, come to the meet and pick up your packet.

	If payment is not received before meet day, you may bring payment to the meet, but you must
	notify the meet director of your plan to do so. If payment is not received, your team will not be allowed to participate.
	LATE FEE: Late entries are strongly discouraged. There is a late fee policy for MSTCA meets. If
	you miss the Monday deadline and still want to compete, <u>you will have to contact the meet</u> <u>director</u> as Direct Athletics will be closed. <u>She is the only one to deal with this problem</u> . The late
	fee structure will be \$50 per relay if contacted by Tuesday, the week of the meet, no later than
	10:00 p.m. The late fee increases to \$100 per relay if contacted by Wednesday, the week of the
	meet, no later than 6:00 p.m. No late entries will accepted after that after 6:00 p.m.
	Schools that enter late entrants must come to the meet with a check or Purchase Order for the
	entry fee plus late fees, to hand to the meet director or they will not be allowed to compete.
Awards	Medals will be awarded for placing 1st through 6th. Team scoring will be 10, 8, 6, 4, 2, 1.
Awarus	A Team Champion and Runner-up trophy will be awarded at the conclusion of the meet.
	Athletes must pick up their awards as soon as the results are announced. Awards will not be
	mailed.
Results	Results will be posted on <u>www.mstca.org</u> , the official MSTCA web site.
Spikes	Only 1/8" or 1/4" PYRAMID spikes allowed. Anyone using needle spikes or longer spikes than
2hive2	recommended will be immediately disqualified and banned for the remainder of the meet.
	Spikes are allowed ONLY in the track area.

Facility Information	The track is a 6-lane composite track with 8 lanes on the straightaway.
	All field events are within walking distance to the track.
	Vehicle parking is on site; bus drop-off at Clark Field Sports Complex, parking at nearby West Springfield High School, unless otherwise directed.

Long Jump	There will be one long jump pit with a painted board

Triple Jump	There will be one triple jump pit with painted boards at 24', 28', 32', 36', 40'

Shot Put	There will be one shot put sector down in the designated throws area past the end of the Clark
	Field parking lot.
	All athletes will get three attempts <u>AND</u> all fair attempts will be measured, but please do not
	bring athletes who have not met the standard.
	Schools must provide shot puts meeting NFHS specifications.
Discus	There will be one discus sector down in the designated throws field past the end of the Clark
	Field parking lot.
	All athletes will get three attempts <u>AND</u> all fair attempts will be measured, but please do not
	bring athletes who have not met the standard.

	Schools must provide discus meeting NFHS specifications.
Javelin	There will be one javelin sector down in the designated throws field past the end of the Clark Field parking lot using a grass runway.  All athletes will get three attempts <u>AND</u> all fair attempts will be measured, but please do not bring athletes who have not met the standard.  Schools must provide javelins meeting NFHS specifications.
Equipment	Schools must provide their own relay batons.  No starting blocks may be used in any event.
